I thank all Committee members for their time and effort in the past year.

I was honoured to take up the role of President in May 2025. I want to express my gratitude to those who have previously guided and supported KCOCA, in particular my predecessors **Matt Willis** (Averill, 1987-91) and **Julyan Lawry** (Middlemore, 1986-87) who did such a fantastic job leading the Committee before me.

We are fortunate to have all committee members returning for another year of service to the KCOCA and I am excited to announce one new nomination for **Amy Auva'a** (Middlemore (2001-02).

As we stand at the intersection of tradition and progress, I am honoured to represent such a diverse and accomplished network of Old Collegians, united by our shared experiences and enduring connection to King's College.

My vision for the Association is simple - to celebrate our rich heritage while fostering new ways for alumni to engage, mentor and support one another, and also the current students who follow in our footsteps. One of the key facets of this vision is the close connections within the King's College affiliates strengthening the

alignment with the Board of Governors, the Foundation, Floreat Semper and The Friends to formulate a cohesive community of King's College supporters.

In the past year we focused on enhancing these alignments through College reunions, professional networking events and other initiatives that gave back to the College. I encourage every Old Collegian to participate, to share your stories, career journeys, and community contributions that make our Association vibrant and relevant.

We started the year with an Old Collegians v First XI cricket match, with a win to the students in this exciting annual event.

In February we connected with the King's community at events in the Northland and Bay of Plenty regions.

Our first Business Breakfast featured two extraordinary young entrepreneurs **Kate Gatfield-Jeffries** (Middlemore, 2015-16) and **Saurav Bansal** (Greenbank, 2012-16) showcasing their talent and business successes. And our second Breakfast featured King's parents **Simon Power QSO** and **Simon Moutter** who shared valuable insights into leadership and the current business landscape.

Anzac Day 2025 marked 100 years since the Memorial Chapel's Dedication Service, and we gathered to remember those Old Collegians and staff who have sacrificed their lives for our country. The Anzac Day Address was given by **Lieutenant Oliver Cook** (School, 2013-17). The College also hosted a Chapel Centenary Service and Dinner to mark this special milestone - a celebration of our Anglican faith and enduring history.

In June Old Collegians connected at events in New York and London, and back home rugby kept us busy throughout the winter with pre-match events, culminating in a fantastic victory in the 1A Final at Eden Park.

Reunion Weekend welcomed many Old Collegians back to the College to connect and reminisce.

We welcomed our Floreat Semper Fellowship for two events. Our Autumn lunch speaker was **Dr Samantha Holdsworth** (Middlemore, 1993-94) and our Spring Lunch speakers were First XV coach **Ian Robinson**, former All Black, and Head of Rugby, **Pita Alatini** (Marsden 1989-94), and moderator **Richard Kidd** (Peart 1969-73).

In October our Old Collegian golfers took another victory in the annual King's College Old Collegians v Auckland Grammar School Old Boys tournament.

In December we hosted our Recent Old Collegians (ROCs) for drinks as many returned home from their studies around New Zealand and overseas.

We were thrilled to welcome a new cohort of Old Collegians with the graduating class of 2025. Our Year 13 leavers and parents farewelled the College with a morning tea and Chapel Service, followed by the traditional Leavers Walk down Memorial Drive as our students depart the gates.

This year we transferred from our Bursary Fund, \$116,152 to support fees for 22 children of Old Collegians. This commitment continues to be the main call on the returns from our investment funds.

The *King's Courier* continues to be our core publication and is produced three times each year in partnership with the College. We encourage our members to please keep us informed about Old Collegian stories, so we can share these updates and successes with the wider community.

Social media following continues to grow and is essential to connect our Old Collegians around the globe. We encourage our members to connect with us via LinkedIn, Facebook and Instagram.

We acknowledge Headmaster **Simon Lamb** who retired at the close of 2025 and was made an Honorary Member of KCOCA I would like to thank Simon for his outstanding service to King's College.

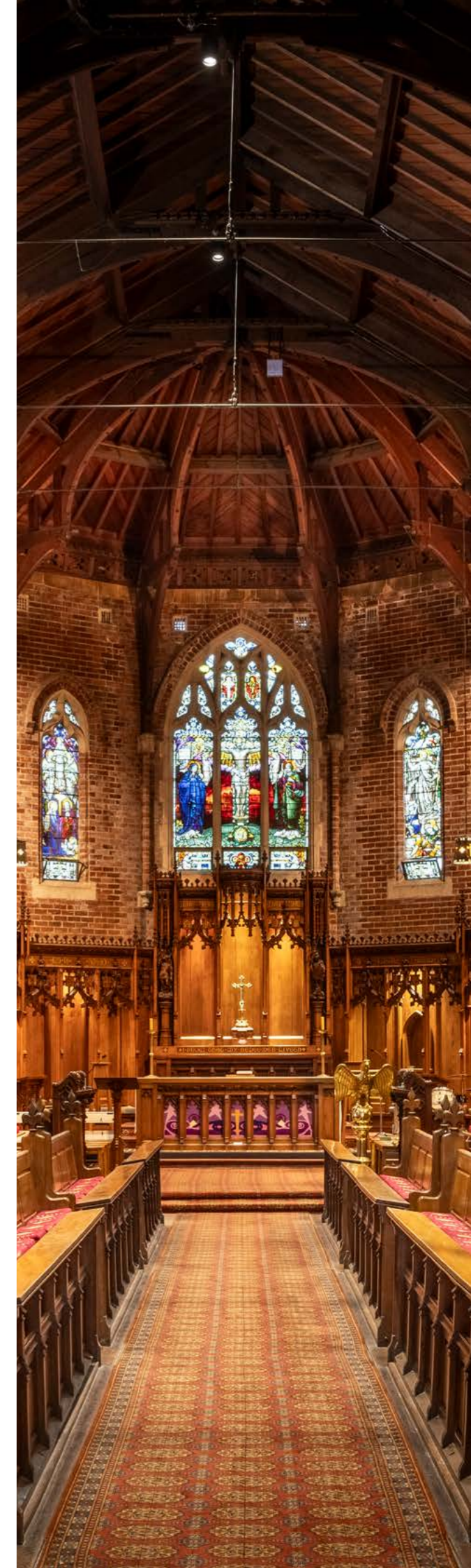

# Financial Report

## Financial

The Association continues to be in a sound financial position. The 2025 annual deficit was \$9,785 (2024: \$15,136). During the year the association transferred \$69,764 for the Courier magazine, the Archivist contribution and general grants (2024: \$57,413). Fee revenue fell slightly and contribution to the college rose.

I would like to acknowledge the work of the College, particularly Kylie Ohms and the Finance team, who assisted the KCOCA in preparing the financial statements in a year of transition.

Total Member's Equity at 31 December 2025 stood at \$336,499 (2024: \$346,285). The Executive Committee's continuing policy is to maintain Total Member's Equity at year end at a minimum of \$100,000. During the course of the year surplus funds have been transferred

to Foundation in order to generate a better return than term deposits.

We thank BDO, our auditors, for the work they have done, and I will be seeking approval that BDO is again appointed as the Association's auditor for 2026.

On a personal note, I would like to thank Tessa Yeoman for all her hard work during the course of the year, we wish her well in her new role at St Cuthberts.

A total of \$116,152 (2024: \$130,700) was paid on behalf of KCOCA to provide 22 Bursaries. The KCOCA Foundation investments performed well in 2025 with a return of 7.2% allowing us to meet our scholarship commitments.

We also acknowledge and thank Graeme Syms, Head of Admissions, for his work and support in the interest of KCOCA Bursaries.

The market value of the Scholarships and Bursaries Fund stood at \$4,065,381 as at 31 December 2025 (2024: \$3,918,888).

The Foundation KCOCA Chapel Preservation Fund stood at \$127,000 (2024: \$118,724).

## Donations

The history of donations by the Association to the Foundation and the history of recent donations to the College are included in this report. the total amount donated now is \$3,935,073 (2024: \$3,790,647).
