Basic Stationery Issue



Year 9 students

- Texts books are generally issued by Departments to students. Where this is not the case students will be informed as to what is required.
- Each student at the College will also be issued a King's College Diary or Guidelines book.

E-Learning Technology Requirements



Our e-learning programme is founded on the premise of 1:1 student possession and use of an iPad for their learning.

All new domestic students will be provided with an iPad, Apple Pencil, keyboard, case, AppleCare cover and support and insurance through three-year or two-year leases (dependent on entry level). Our model of device provision is as below:

iPad Programme Model 2025 onwards



By using a standard model of acquisition and deployment, the College is better positioned to enable both teachers and students to collaborate with learning resources and workflows, and for all students to benefit from the advantages of the programme:

- 1. Device equity all students have the same device, apps and peripherals.
- 2. iPad use is focused on schoolwork and learning students' iPads are set up exclusively for use in the school environment.
- 3. iPads will be kept up to date iPadOS updates and required apps are pushed by the College's Device Management System.
- 4. Devices can be retained at the end of Year 13 by paying a residual amount.
- 5. Complete technical support and replacement if a student's iPad is permanently damaged (restrictions and discretion apply). Insurance cover is provided for loss or theft (conditions apply).
- 6. Complete cover with AppleCare and 24/7 technical support of related Apple products and software for staff, students and parents.
- 7. Students will be provided with a Managed Apple ID on arrival which will facilitate some of the software we use, such as Apple Classroom, and enable collaborative engagement in their schoolwork.
- 8. The Managed Apple ID provides every student with 200GB free iCloud storage.

With this initiative, the use of technologies such as Apple Classroom has improved engagement between staff and students and allows teachers to ensure students remain on task and learning during their lessons.

The costs for the iPad Package will vary each year. Indicative costs for 2025, based on the student's entry Year Level, are below

Frequently asked questions:

Q: Do I have to use a King's College supplied iPad?

A: Yes, this is because the iPads are setup to be managed and controlled by King's College. Apple licensing terms prevents us from managing BYOD iPads in the same way as iPads owned by the College.

Q: How do we pay for this?

A: Costs for the iPad package will be paid annually, charged to your incidentals account in January or February. The cost you are charged will depend on the Year Level your child is in and will be made clear in the device usage agreement we require you to sign before receiving the iPad.

Q: Can we use a laptop instead? I already have an iPad, can I use that?

A: No. iPads are required for class as some of the technology is not available on the laptops (writing, apps etc.). BYOD devices cannot be used as we cannot manage these in the same way due to Apple's licensing conditions.

Q: How and when do we get the iPad Package?

A: The iPad package will be delivered to your home address prior to Christmas so your child can familiarise themselves with it over the holiday break. The iPad will come with some instructions on how to set it up. We will confirm your postal address along with requiring a parent to sign a device use agreement prior to sending the iPad out to you.

Q: What does the insurance cover?

A: The insurance covers up to three repairs (providing repair does not cost more than replacement cost), and one replacement. This covers both accidental damage, loss, and theft. If the device is replaced via insurance, parents are required to pay for a new policy on the replacement device to ensure it remains covered by insurance.

Q: What happens with the iPad if the student leaves during the year or before the device provision agreement term ends?

A: Parents may elect to retain the device. This will require payment of remaining annual payments and the buyout price for the device. The buyout cost varies per year and device, but it is known at the beginning of the agreement period.


School Holiday Hours are:
