**\* Subject Options Day:**

- If a student has not gained the prerequisite standard for taking a subject they have selected, they will need to attend this day in order to gain approval to continue with that subject option or gain approval for an alternative subject option.
- If a student has changed their mind and wishes to make a voluntary subject change, they will need to attend this day in order to gain approval for that change.

**\*\* Orientation Day:**

- All new students (day and boarding) are expected to attend the Orientation Day.
- Te Pūtake Lodge students and Year 13 Boarding House student leaders return on the evening of Monday 31 January (the night before Orientation Day).
- All other returning boarders return on the evening of Tuesday 1 February (Orientation Day).
- Returning day students are not expected to attend the Orientation Day, unless they are Year 13 Day House student leaders. Day Housemasters will communicate arrangements directly with those students.
