- 2) If a student has changed their mind and wishes to make a voluntary subject change, they will need to attend this day in order to gain approval for that change.

*² Orientation Day:

- 1) All new students (day and boarding) are expected to attend the Orientation Day.
- 2) Te Pūtake Lodge students and Year 13 Boarding House student leaders return on the evening of Monday 27 January (the night before Orientation Day).
- 3) All other returning boarders return on the evening of Tuesday, 28 January (Orientation Day).
- 4) Returning day students are not expected to attend the Orientation Day, unless they are Year 13 Day House student leaders. Day Housemasters will communicate arrangements directly with those students.
