^{*1} Subject Options Day:

- If a student has not gained the prerequisite standard for taking a subject they have selected, they will need to attend this day in order to gain approval to continue with that subject option or gain approval for an alternative subject option.
- If a student has changed their mind and wishes to make a voluntary subject change, they will need to attend this day in order to gain approval for that change at the following times – Year 13 morning; Y12 afternoon; Y11 and students from out of Auckland, all day.

^{*2} Orientation Day:

- All new students (day and boarding) are expected to attend the Orientation Day.
- Te Pūtāke Lodge students and Year 13 Boarding House student leaders return on the evening of Monday 1 February (the night before Orientation Day).
- All other returning boarders return on the evening of Tuesday, 2 February (Orientation Day).
- Returning day students are not expected to attend the Orientation Day, unless they are Year 13 Day House student leaders. Day Housemasters will communicate arrangements directly with those students.
